Your guide handles logistics so you can focus on stories, photos, and food. Accommodation is not included, so you can choose your own hotel in central Tbilisi and meet us each morning.

Tour itinerary

Day 1: Old Tbilisi, Narikala & Modern Icons

Meet your guide in central Tbilisi and start in Abanotubani — the sulfur bath district that gave the city its name. Walk through the brick-domed bathhouses, then climb (or take the cable car) to Narikala Fortress for the classic panorama over the Old Town and the Mtkvari River. Continue to Metekhi cliff church, cross the Bridge of Peace, and stroll past Rike Park toward Freedom Square and Rustaveli Avenue. End the day with optional Georgian wine tasting or a traditional dinner recommendation in the Old Town.

Day 2: UNESCO Day Trip: Mtskheta & Jvari

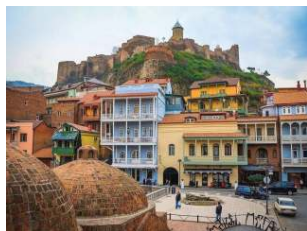
Morning private transfer to Mtskheta, Georgia's ancient capital and a UNESCO World Heritage site (about 30–40 minutes). Visit Jvari Monastery for sweeping views of the confluence of the Mtkvari and Aragvi rivers, then explore Svetitskhoveli Cathedral — the spiritual heart of Georgian Orthodoxy — and Samtavro Monastery. Free time for coffee and crafts in the old streets. Return to Tbilisi in the afternoon. Optional evening: Mtatsminda Park funicular sunset or a leisurely walk along the Dry Bridge flea market area.

Day 3: Living Traditions & Farewell Tbilisi

Start at the Open Air Museum of Ethnography (or Chronograph / Georgian National Museum, depending on season and interest) for a compact look at Georgia's regions and crafts. Continue with a scenic stop on Mtatsminda or Turtle Lake for photos and fresh air. Afternoon free time for

shopping on Aghmashenebeli or in the Old Town boutiques. Farewell lunch or early dinner featuring khachapuri, khinkali, and seasonal dishes — then hotel drop-off. Perfect end to a three-day Tbilisi immersion.
