

SKI TOUR CHALLENGE - MT. Kazbegi

About this tour

Enjoy 2500m of exciting descent from the shoulder of Mount Kazbegi, one of the highest and most picturesque peaks in Georgia. This ski-touring summit is excellent for experienced skiers, with spring being the best time to enjoy the thrilling descent from the plateau to the valley.

Mount Kazbegi is associated with the myth of Prometheus, who was chained on the mountain in punishment for having stolen fire from the gods and given it to mortals.

This tour offers a unique adventure experience, with breathtaking views of the high peaks, roaring rivers, and mountain lifestyle of Georgia's northern borderlands.

Tour itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Tbilisi

Arrival in Tbilisi, met and assisted at the airport.

Day 2: Tbilisi - Stepantsminda

Travel to Stepantsminda via Mtskheta (UNESCO site) to see the high peaks, roaring rivers, and mountain lifestyle of Georgia's northern borderlands.

Day 3: Stepantsminda - Bethlemi Hut

Ski-tour to Bethlemi hut (3675 m), former Meteorological station.

Day 4: The Bethlemi Hut - Mt. Ortsveri

Ski-tour to the north saddle of Mt. Ortsveri (4300 m), ascent to the summit via northern ridge (II UIAA), and descent to the meteorological station.

Day 5: The Bethlemi Hut - Mt. Kazbegi

Ski tour to Mt. Kazbegi north slope (4600 - 4800 m), ascent to the summit via ice-snow slope (5054 m, II UIAA), and descent to the meteorological station.

Day 6: The Bethlemi Hut - Stepantsminda

Descent to Stepantsminda.

Day 7: Stepantsminda - Tbilisi

Enjoy a leisure evening in Tbilisi, rest and relax in Tbilisi sulfur bath houses.

Day 8: Departure

Transfer to Tbilisi international airport for departure.
